

Since electric motors were developed by Faraday and other inventors in the mid nineteenth century, and the first fans were being manufactured by Eddison and Emmerson at the beginning of the last century, little changed in what was a relatively reliable and efficient product.

That changed when Climate Change focused on the huge amount of power that electric motors were using (over 60% of industrial energy) and directives such as MEPs and Ecodirectives have since brought rapid changes to a very traditional product.

As IE3 becomes the norm for motor efficiency in 2015:

- Where are the designs of electric motors systems heading?
- What will become the favoured designs and for what applications?
- As the main items absorbing this energy, how will pumps, fans and compressors change?
- How important will the management of these assets become to maintain them at peak efficiency and peak reliability?
