Latest Development within EMiR Software

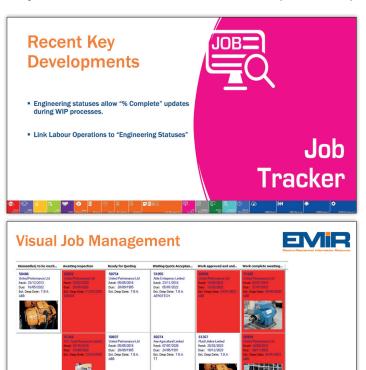
As presented at the latest Open Day, here are a few highlights from the recent developments that have featured within EMiR.

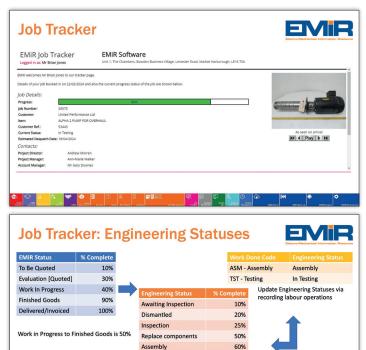


Job Tracker allows your customers to access job information, so they can see how their jobs are progressing through your works. A status bar shows how complete the job is and a customer can see any of their jobs where they are listed

as the contact. We have recently made a change to link labour operations to 'engineering statuses' so by performing a labour task the progress bar will automatically update as to how complete the job is. This means there is minimal effort required to keep

the customer fully informed of progress! Another bonus of this change, is that Visual Job Management is then effortless, and jobs will move to the next process in the repair/service/build cycle simply based on the activities your engineers' record against jobs. Whether you record labour via Smart Site, live time with our Time and Attendance Extension, or simply enter time sheets manually into the EMIR Time Sheet system, all entries will update the engineering status accordingly and make the whole process so much easier.



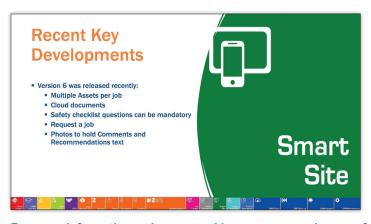




Smart Site – Version 6 continues develop at pace. Changes that are currently in progress will allow engineers to record non-productive labour on the device as well as review all the hours they have booked in a period. The job list is also being

substantially re-designed to look more like a calendar of events, so if the same job is booked for an engineer on multiple days, then the job will be listed on every day that it is booked. This alleviates the need for any other calendar view and directly informs the user of where they required to attend and when.

Engineering Statuses can fill in gaps and give more detailed updates
