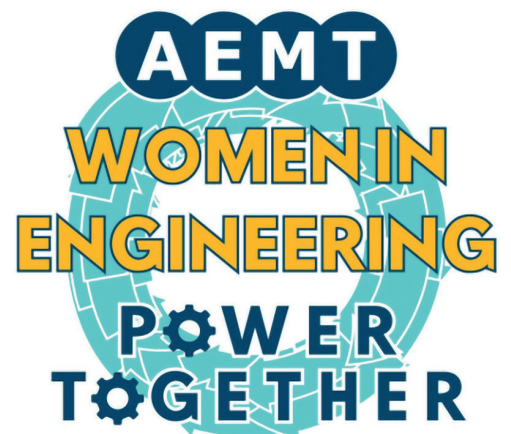
Delivered in collaboration with the Association of Electrical & Mechanical Trades (AEMT), the session built on the momentum created at the AEMT Conference “Power Hour” and reinforced a simple but powerful idea: when women are given the space to speak openly, the industry benefits.

The room brought together a diverse mix of roles – from engineers and apprentices to operational and office-based professionals – all contributing honest insight into the realities of working in a traditionally male-dominated sector. The aim is to better understand the roles women hold across the sector, the challenges they face, and the support they need – ensuring future initiatives are driven by real insight from within the industry.

Looking ahead, the conversation doesn’t stop here. A follow-on #PowerTogether session will take place at the AEMT Conference on 24th September, where the survey results will be shared, discussed and actioned upon.

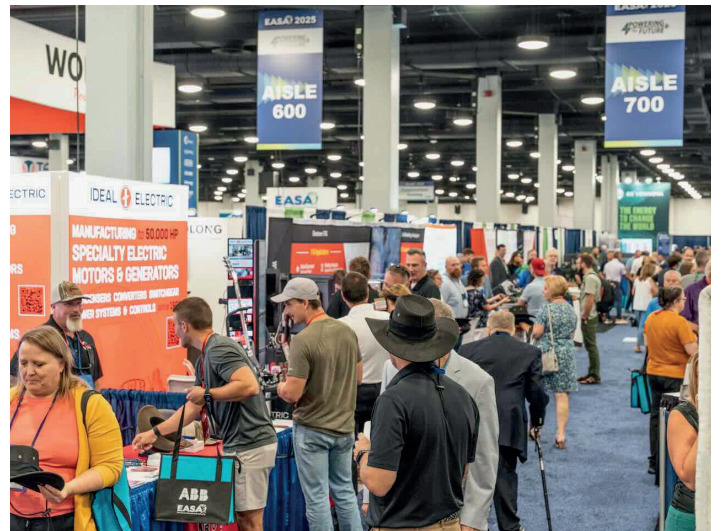

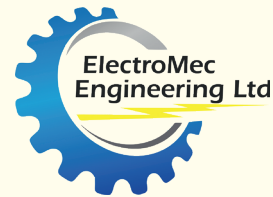
